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SOUTH INDUSTRIAL PARK

Le Pont de Claix, Champagnier, Jarrie

Built in the spirit of industrial ecology and sustainability, South Industrial Park is a collection of industrial sites dedicated to specific sectors with extensive infrastructure needs, offering an integrated network of mutualized resources (hydrogen, energy, etc.) designed to lessen the zone's environmental impacts.

- 250 ha dedicated to industry and manufacturing Sectors: energy, mechanics, chemicals/
- environment, process engineering, etc. An industrial and institutional ecosystem with



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CHAMROUSSE CONNECTED MOUNTAIN PARK RESORT

Chamrousse

The Chamrousse Connected Mountain Park Resort intends to create a 100% green, innovative model resort. Located 30 minutes from the Grenoble city centre, and 90 minutes from Lyon, Chamrousse is the "historic" ski resort from the 1968 Olympics. It offers a 400 Ha mountain resort for hiking, biking, skiing (alpine and nordic), with ski runs and accessible off-piste skiing, suitable for all levels and styles. The Chamrousse Connected Mountain Park & Resort project aims to create a cutting-edge Four-Season, Smart Mountain Resort destination for tourism, city-breaks and conferences.

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GRANDALPE

Grenoble, Échirolles, Eybens

An ambitious urban renewal project transforming a formerly underexploited zone, the GrandAlpe development project promises new and extensive economic opportunities for a broad range of activities, including professional space, residential neighborhoods, shops and more, as well as easy access to the area from all of Grenoble's major


